Liability Release and Waiver

Upon signature, I fully recognize that there are dangers and risks to which I may be exposed by participating in the above-mentioned event sponsored by Marquette University Office of Engagement and Inclusion, Center for Community Service. Please see the guidelines and protocols. Participation includes **transporting in personal vehicles, and/or walking to homes of elderly or disabled Milwaukee residents to help winterize their homes and help with fall clean up. This may include using electric trimmers, brooms, removing window air conditioners, raking leaves, trimming bushes, cleaning windows and garages, mowing lawns, picking up garbage, and/or putting away lawn supplies/equipment at various private residences in Milwaukee County, WI ("Activity").**

Due to COVID-19, Make a Difference Day 2020 will take a different format in an effort to ensure the health and safety of all participants. We will be observing all recommended COVID-19 guidelines mandated by Marquette University and public health experts. We ask and expect that all participants follow the following guidelines below:

- All participants are required to wear a mask for the entirety of the event. This includes while providing services at the homes of senior adults and while transporting to the site.
- Per health guidelines, participants must maintain the six-foot social distancing rule as mandated by Marquette University and health experts.
- Marquette University requires that only two individuals ride in each vehicle to maintain the six-foot social distancing rule. We expect all participants to observe this protocol.

I have signed this Liability Release and Waiver in full recognition of the dangers, hazards, and risks of taking part in this Activity, which dangers include, but are not limited to, physical injuries (minimal, serious, catastrophic) and/or property damage or loss.

I understand that Marquette University does not require me to participate in this Activity, but I want to do so, despite the possible dangers and risks and despite this Release.

I therefore agree to assume and take upon myself all of the risks and responsibilities in any way associated with this Activity in consideration of, and in return for, the services, facilities, and other assistance provided to me by Marquette University and its governing board, employees, and agents, from any and all liability, claims, and actions that may arise from injury or harm to me, from my death or from loss or damage to my property in connection with this Activity.

I understand that this Release covers liability, claims and actions caused entirely or in part by any acts or failure to act of Marquette University or its governing board, employees or agents, including but not limited to negligence, mistake, or failure to supervise by Marquette.

I recognize that this Release means I am giving up, among other things, rights to sue Marquette University, its governing board, employees and agents for injuries, damages or losses I may incur. I also understand that this Release binds my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, as well as myself.

I am 18 years of age or older, I have read this entire Release, I fully understand it, and I agree to be legally bound by it.
